



## Horizon Flight Center VETERANS AGREEMENT

### Montgomery GI Bill Student - Please reference - <https://gibill.custhelp.com/app/home>

- 1) A 2<sup>nd</sup> class medical is required before flight training begins. ATP courses require a 1<sup>st</sup> class medical.
- 2) All training is paid by the veteran following each flight.
- 3) VA reimbursement will be sent directly to the veteran.
- 4) Reimbursement times vary and can take up to 4 to 8 weeks or more.
- 5) All courses have a maximum dollar amount, flight hour amount, ground hour amount, and pre/post amount. It is up to the veteran to know these amounts and if veteran exceeds these amounts the VA will not reimburse the coverage.
- 6) Training supplies, including kits, books, etc. are not reimbursable under this bill.
- 7) Lasergrade written tests are an out-of-pocket expense.
- 8) Final checkrides are an out of pocket expense.
- 9) All plans rent wet. Cross-country flight gas is an out of pocket expense, unless VA gas card is used.

### Post 9/11 GI Bill Student - Please reference - <https://gibill.custhelp.com/app/home>

- 1) A 2<sup>nd</sup> class medical is required before flight training begins. ATP courses require a 1<sup>st</sup> class medical.
- 2) Additionally, veterans must maintain a valid 2<sup>nd</sup> class or 1<sup>st</sup> class medical for the entirety of his/her flight training using VA benefits.
- 3) A Certificate of Eligibility is required from the VA before veteran will be allowed to charge flight training to his/her HFC "special account".
- 4) VA will reimburse Horizon Flight Center (HFC) directly to clear the above charged "special account".
- 5) If veteran wishes to begin training and has not received his/her Certificate of Eligibility, veteran will be required to pay for all of training following each flight. Upon the VA reimbursing HFC veteran will be reimbursed.
- 6) All courses have a maximum dollar amount, flight hour amount, ground hour amount, and pre/post amount. It is up to the veteran to know these amounts and if veteran exceeds these amounts the VA will not reimburse the coverage.
- 7) If the VA does not cover any portion of veteran training or if student exceeds the amount that the VA will cover, it will be up to the student to pay any amounts owed.
- 8) Training supplies, including kits, books, etc. are not reimbursable under this bill.
- 9) Lasergrade written tests are an out-of-pocket expense.
- 10) Final checkrides are an out of pocket expense.
- 11) All plans rent wet. Cross-country flight gas is an out-of-pocket expense, unless VA gas card is used.

- 13) All students are required to place a credit card on file. This credit card will be charged if the student exceeds VA course program amounts.
- 14) The credit card will be charged if a student is not authorized for 100% funding. (ie: if a student is approved for 90% funding, the credit card will be charged for the remaining 10%)
